Glimpse 1 – the GeneralChapter Delegates – October 5, 2023


One Month Until the General Chapter and Counting Down

These past few days, I have received the preparatory materials for the 36th General Chapter for the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament. This event will be hosted in the province of the Martyrs in Vietnam, held in the Provincial House in Thu Duc City, Ho Chi Minh City, Viet Nam. Every six years, the leaders of each of the provinces and regions of our religious congregation and a delegate from each place come together to meet and hear past successes, plan our future, and elect leadership for the next six years. During this event, I'll explain moments through these regular "glimpses" of the Chapter, expanding on these elements of the Chapter. A Chapter is an official "religious life" term for a business meeting, but there is also a spiritual element. We will have a retreat, this time focusing on the 40th anniversary of our *Rule of Life*.

Before I get ahead of myself, knowing how the two United States representatives (*Father John Thomas Lane SSS and Father Norman Pelletier SSS*) were chosen to attend



the General Chapter is helpful. When I was elected provincial last August 11, 2022, I was also selected by "right," or by the title of my office, to attend and represent the Province of Saint Ann. Depending on the size of a province's membership, you are afforded a delegate or two. We can elect one delegate since we are a province of less



than 100 members. Father Norman Pelletier was voted for this role. (*Father John Keenan was also elected an alternate delegate in case Father Norman could not.*) Father Norman is well-acquainted with having served as a delegate previously, Vicar General of the Congregation, and General Superior. He has also gone several times as Provincial Superior of the Province of Saint Ann and as former General Superior. I've been fortunate to lead the music and liturgy at two General Chapters (1999 Rio de Janeiro, Brazil and 2017 Mundelein, Illinois).

During these events, we can meet religious from across the globe in the Eymardian Family, fellow male religious, a few women religious (*Servants of the Blessed Sacrament*), Servitium Christi, and Associates of the Blessed Sacrament. For instance, at the 2017 General Chapter, with a day focusing on the Aggregation of the Blessed Sacrament and its formation, the previous director of the Center for Eucharistic Evangelizing (CEE),
