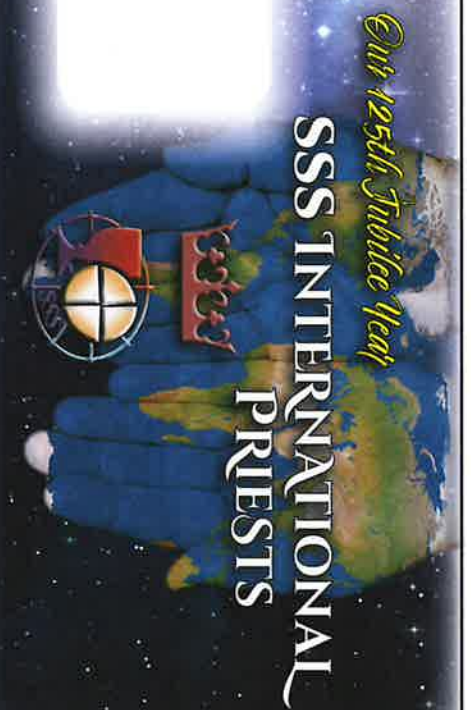

Almost 125 years ago, four Canadian men from Montreal, Quebec, Canada came to New York, New York, USA to start a new foundation of Eucharistic ministry. This dream of our founder, Saint Peter Julian Eymard, continued his vision to spread to the 4-corners of the world, beginning from his work in Paris, France, to “set the world on fire with the Eucharist.” During this time of Eucharistic Renewal in the United States, our order is posed to celebrate our own anniversary of service in the United States. 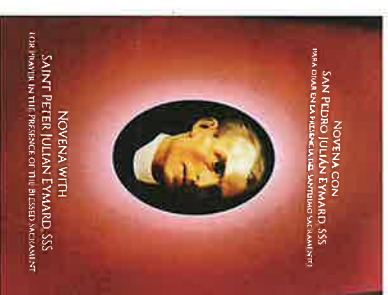
