## The Eymardian Family Gathered at Various Times During of the 53<sup>rd</sup> International Eucharistic Congress in Ecuador

The Eymardian Family gathered at different times together during the International Eucharistic Congress. Mona Grigsby-Suarez, Co-director of the Center for Eucharistic

Later in the day, we joined together in the evening with the Peruvian & Columbian SSS Family members. The photo to the left is in front of the Basilica of the National Vow (to the Sacred Heart of Jesus). As mentioned earlier, the president and an Ecuador priest proposed a national basilica to honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus one hundred and fifty years ago. The government and all provinces each gave funds to build the basilica. It is not complete yet, and when it is complete, they believe it will be the end of the world!

On a brief tour, we went to the famous Marian statue in Quito, highest in the world. For fifty-three years, Our Lady of Panacillo has guarded the city of Quito, holding back the chains of evil. She is over a mountain near the old city part of Quito at one end of a boulevard that ends at the National Basilica.

A family (Gross from Italy) shares how they felt called to move from Italy to share lives in Ecuador, committing their lives to living the Eucharist with those who live in the rural areas of Ecuador. The children, too, live in a barrio with their parents, who organize through NGO's to build furniture (as seen behind them and used during the Congress). Each presentation on the Eucharist was followed by a witness of putting the



Eucharistic into practice. This family moved us, especially the children. Not pictured here (due to the internet being shut down), Mary Wu (Taiwan), who shared how she and the Archdiocese where she serves as liaison for youth ministry, have worked at having children



catechize and pray in the presence of the Eucharist. When teaching 5-year-olds, she shared a story of a little boy saying that she heard Jesus tell him he was a good boy. Mary asked the boy what he told Christ back. The boy said, "I love you, Jesus!"


