



1st Anniversary of the Province Associates Council

I am pleased to serve for the first year in the inaugural Saint Ann (USA) Province Associates Council. In the Project of Life 24, the leadership of the Aggregation of the Blessed Sacrament, or Associates, has local, national, and international levels. The August 2022 Provincial Chapter of the men's branch instructed the province and council to revive the Center for Eucharistic Evangelizing (CEE) and assist in running the office. Father John Thomas Lane SSS, our provincial, in reviewing the CEE and Project of Life, felt it was now the time, as the Associates have grown with branches across the country, to have a council that would assist the CEE and its (co)director(s) and the Provincial Council of the Province. In the Spring of 2023, the CEE and its co-directors, Mary Muehle and Mona

Grigsby-Suarez, worked with the Provincial Council to start the process and structure to assist leadership and collaborate. Here's a timeline of some of our highlights:

October 2023 - In collaboration with the CEE, Associate Branch leaders defined the Council's purpose, priorities, leadership roles, and responsibilities

December 2023 - First bi-monthly Province Associate Council Zoom meeting attended by newly appointed Associate branch Council members and alternate Council meeting agendas follow a standard agenda set by the CEE directors *(See attached document)*

The council chair (currently me) meets with CEE directors and the Provincial to plan the agenda for the Council meeting.

At council meetings, council members share Associate branch happenings, resources, challenges, and solutions. CEE and Provincial give reports.

Summary notes/minutes of meetings, action items, and audio recordings of Zoom meetings are sent to Council members, alternates, CEE co-directors, and Provincial Superior.
