PRE-TOUR TO BARCELONA

October 7, Wednesday – Depart the USA on an overnight flight to Barcelona.

October 8, Thursday – Arrive in Barcelona, meet your guide and transfer to the city for a panoramic city tour. (D)

October 9, Friday - Full day visit to the Monastery of Montserrat with Mass. (D)

October 10, Saturday – Visit to Sagrada Familia Church and the Cathedral of Barcelona. Afternoon and evening at leisure. (B)

October 11, Sunday – Transfer to the airport for the flight to Marseilles to meet with the group arriving from the USA.

MAIN TOUR

October 10, Saturday, Day 1: DEPART FROM USA

Depart from New York/JFK International Airport, on an overnight flight to Marseille, France. Dinner and breakfast are served on the flight. Quotes for add-on flights and optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades are available upon request. We work with group airfares that do not allow seat selection. If you wish to reserve specific seats on the flights, we recommend purchasing our own airline ticket and booking the land-only option with us.

October 11, Sunday, Day 2: MARSEILLE, FRANCE

We arrive in France today and are greeted by our professional English-speaking tour manager, who will be our host for the following days. We board the bus and begin a panoramic city tour of Marseille, a city with a rich spiritual history. Mass will be celebrated, marking the beginning of our spiritual journey. Dinner and overnight in Marseille. (D)

October 12, Monday, Day 3: MARSEILLE

After breakfast, we delve into the early inspirations of St. Peter Julian Eymard. Our tour takes us to sites significant to his early Eucharistic vision, including the Church of Saint Joseph and the site of the first Blessed Sacrament Congregation chapel and community house, Villa Chateaubriand. In the history of the Blessed Sacrament Congregation, Marseille is notable as the Congregation's first religious community established outside of Paris. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner is at leisure in Marseille. (B)

October 13, Tuesday, Day 4: EUCHARISTIC MIRACLE OF AVIGNON

Today features a profound spiritual journey to Avignon, the site of a historic Eucharistic Miracle that occurred in 1433. This miracle, a powerful affirmation of Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist, offers a deeply Uplifting experience. Our visit includes the Grey Friars' Chapel, the impressive Papal Palace and gardens, and the Avignon Cathedral. Mass will be celebrated, further uplifting our spirits. Return to Marseille for dinner and an overnight stay. (B.D)

October 14, Wednesday, Day 5: NOTRE DAME DU LAUS

According to legend, it is above the village of Saint-Etienne-le-Laus that the Virgin Mary first appeared to the shepherdess Benoîte Rencurel in May 1664. Throughout her appearances, the Virgin requested the construction of a church and a house for the priests in the hamlet of Laus, to attract Christians seeking conversion. Mary's appearances were officially recognized by the Church and proclaimed on May 4, 2008. Our visit includes the Basilica, the Chapel of Bon Rencontre, and the house of visionary Benoîte Rencurel. This holy site was also known to St. Peter Julian Eymard, who was inspired by the visionary's deep prayer life and Eucharistic devotion. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Laus. (B.D)

October 15, Thursday, Day 6: LA SALETTE - LA MURE

After breakfast and check-out, we enjoy a scenic drive to La Salette, nestled in the French Alps. This morning, we visit the beautiful Shrine of Our Lady of La Salette, located high in the French Alps. In 1846, a weeping Blessed Mother appeared to two shepherd children. She brought them a dire warning, asking for repentance, prayer, and penance. We celebrate Mass at the Basilica, followed by Eucharistic Adoration (TBC), and a drink of the spring water that sprang forth from where Our Lady appeared. From here, we continue to La Mure, the birthplace of St. Peter Julian Eymard, for dinner and overnight. (B.D)

October 16, Friday, Day 7: LA MURE – MONTEYNARD - GRENOBLE

In the morning, we visit the town of La Mure, where Eymard was raised as a child and where he worked in his father's business. After lunch, we continue our journey. En route, we stop in Monteynard, a site of personal prayer and retreat for St. Eymard. Then proceed to Grenoble, where he began to embrace his Eucharistic mission more fully. Here we visit the site of the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament and the Church of St. Louis (TBC). Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Grenoble. (B.D)

October 17, Saturday, Day 8: LA MURE - CHATTE - LYON

Following breakfast and check out, we journey toward Lyon, stopping along the way in Chatte. Here, St. Eymard lived with his sister and discerned his call to found a new religious congregation. After lunch at leisure, we continue to Lyon and visit key Catholic sites, including the Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourvière, the Church of Saint Martin d'Ainay, and the Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament, where St. Eymard often prayed and ministered. Additional site visits include the original community house of the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament in Lyon and locations tied to his preaching and pastoral work. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Lyon. (B.D)

October 18, Sunday, Day 9: LYON - SAINT-BONNET-LE-FROID

After breakfast, we enjoy a day trip to Saint-Bonnet-le-Froid, where St. Eymard served as a young priest. Visit the local parish church and explore the peaceful village that helped shape his early pastoral experi-

ence. Mass will be celebrated. Return to Lyon for the evening. Dinner is at leisure to experience the renowned culinary scene in the gastronomic capital of France. Overnight in Lyon. (B)

October 19, Monday, Day 10: LYON - DIJON - WINERY VISIT - PARIS

Depart Lyon and travel toward Paris, pausing in Dijon to visit the Church of Notre-Dame, the site of a Eucharistic Miracle from 1430 in which the host dissolved and the Precious Blood appeared in the chalice. Enjoy a cultural stop at a local winery in the Burgundy region before arriving in Paris for the evening. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner is at leisure. Overnight in Paris. (B.Special lunch)

October 20, Tuesday, Day 11: EYMARD'S PARIS – NOTRE DAME – SACRE COEUR

Our day in Paris is dedicated to exploring sites significant to both Catholic heritage and the life of St. Eymard. We begin the day with a panoramic tour of the city, featuring its highlights, including the Eiffel Tower, where we make a photo stop. Then, we visit the newly rebuilt Notre-Dame Cathedral, which we explore on a guided tour, and ascend to the Sacré-Cœur Basilica, where Adoration is ongoing and we celebrate Mass. Our final visit of the day is to the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament's headquarters. Dinner and overnight in Paris. (B.D)

October 21, Wednesday, Day 12: PARIS

We begin the day with a visit to Rue du Bac, the site of the Miraculous Medal apparitions. Mass will be celebrated. We can visit the nearby church to see where St. Vincent de Paul's remains are housed, or you can choose to explore Paris at your own pace. Suggested activities include visiting Saint-Sulpice or Sainte-Chapelle, exploring one of the many Museums, including the Cluny Museum, walking through the Luxembourg Gardens, or doing some last-minute shopping. Tonight, we gather for our farewell dinner on the Seine River Cruise. Our trip concludes with music and wine as we watch the illuminated Paris from the river. Overnight in Paris. (B. Special dinner)

October 22, Thursday, Day 13: RETURN TO USA

After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flight home. (B)

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.
